Camp Information:

Bjørnetann Language and Cultural Camp will be held at the Billings Lions Club Camp, located ten miles south of Red Lodge on the west fork of Rock Creek.

The camp offers a meeting area, commercial kitchen and sleeping accommodations. A nurse and a cook will be on staff.

An adult must accompany children under the age of ten. Adults are welcome with or without children.

Attendees are asked to help keep the camp clean. KP Duty is shared by all campers. Volunteer instructors will teach Norwegian language, history, culture, and crafts.

In the past we have been able to assign one family per cabin; however depending on attendance, we may not be able to do that in every situation. We try to assign girls and women cabins near the women's restroom facilities. Boys and men, near the men's restroom facilities.

There are a couple of forest service campgrounds very close to the Lions Camp if you should choose to bring your own camper. There is a KOA campground near Red Lodge. (If you decide to stay at the campground, we cannot discount the camp fee.)

There is limited RV parking at the camp and no hookups. Please call Nancy Alley first to make sure there's room available.

Memorial Hall is for campers who have mobility problems. It is available on a first come basis with limited room.
