CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THESE RULES APPLY TO EVERYONE AT CAMP.

Bjørnetann aims to provide a safe, caring, and fun camp for all. The Liability Form and this Form **must** be signed acknowledging these rules.

1. Campers must attend all classes listed on their schedules, and wear name tags at all times.
2. Be on time for meals. Remember to wear your name tag. Dress appropriately. Pajamas, bathing suits, tube tops, bikini tops, and bare feet are not allowed in the Dining Hall.
3. Clean-up is the responsibility of **everyone**, including staff. KP duty is assigned by cabin(s) at the beginning of camp. If you use any dishes such as cups to get a drink between meals it is **your** responsibility to make sure it's returned and left at the KP counter. Campers are responsible for keeping their own accommodation clean and picking up behind themselves in the bathing area.
4. Respectful behavior is expected. If a camper behaves in a disrespectful manner or breaks the rules, the camp director will notify the camper, or accompanying adult if a youth is involved. In a major situation the Board of Directors will be consulted. Be aware that this could include sending the camper home at their own expense. **Any issue regarding drugs, alcohol, bullying, or repeated behavioral problems will be brought to the attention of the Board of Directors.**
5. **Bullying**, foul or obscene language, bad attitudes, and name-calling will not be tolerated.
6. Bjørnetann is not responsible for lost, broken, or stolen articles. Please leave valuables at home. Musical instruments may be brought but should be well marked and played quietly.
7. There is no cell or wireless in the area so please leave phones in your cabin.
8. Knives and weapons are **not** allowed at camp.
9. Smoking is not allowed in any building. Alcohol and illegal drugs are not allowed in the camp.
10. Bjørnetann does provide mandatory classes for preschool through age 12 children. We are unable to accommodate all age groups in all the adult programs during class times. Youngsters from age 10 up will be permitted in those adult classes. The accompanying adult is responsible for the child at all times.
11. Adults leaving camp for any reason must sign out on the Sign In/Out sheet located in the Dining Hall. **If a child is leaving camp or is unable to attend class, the accompanying adult must record this information and advise the Camp Director.**
12. All hikes out of the immediate area must be adult supervised. **The river is out of bounds.**
13. Campers must not damage property, destroy, or harm animals or plants. Sunflower seeds are to be eaten outdoors only.
14. Pets are not encouraged but they are also not prohibited. Please keep in mind you may be sharing a cabin with other people besides your family members, and your cabin mates may not be comfortable sharing their cabin with a pet or may have allergies. All pets must be leashed and **under control** when walking. Please be considerate and pick up after your pet.
15. On Sunday, pack up **all** of your belongings and **leave your cabin clean**. Everything must be out of the rooms by 12:00pm, as well as the garbage removed and the floors swept before cabin inspections. If cabins are left in an unacceptable state, a **cleanup fee of \$20 per cabin** may be charged.
